
U Organizational Lists Box Contents



Example: Box 2 with contents. The Inquisition plaque is so long it has been cut in three equal pieces to fit in the box. This is not necessary though, as one long plaque might give a better impression—almost 600 years of torture and killing by the Church for which the Church has apologized.
